Subject: **BID EVALUATION REPORT.**

In pursuance of directions of the Honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan, the Ministry of Religious Affairs and Interfaith Harmony constituted a Committee to develop separate criteria for scrutiny/assessment of profiles of existing and newly enrolled companies strictly in light of the guidelines provided by the Honourable Court in Dossani case dated 27.08.2013.

2. The Committee in its meeting held on 22.08.2017 recommended hiring of an audit firm to scrutinize profiles of existing and newly enrolled HGOs for purpose of allocation of Hajj Quota for Hajj-2018. Therefore, the Ministry invited bids for selection of prospective firms. Copy of advertisement, bidding document and TORs is at **Annex-I, II and III** respectively.


3. The bid was opened in presence of bidders/their representatives on 03.11.2017. Total 12 (twelve) bidders participated in the bid opening meeting. The committee evaluated the credentials of bidders on basis of criteria contained in the bidding document. Details of evaluation of the prospective bidders are as under:-


*Condition No.(iii) mentioned in the advertisement requires that the firm must have presence in all provinces of Pakistan.

4. Based on the above evaluation the committee unanimously recommended as under:-

- i) The bids of M/s Munif Ziauddin & Co. and M/s Zahid Jamil & Co. may be termed as non compliant for non deposit of bid security with their bid.
- ii) The bidders who contrary to advertised condition have no office in four provinces may also be termed as non compliant.
- iii) After detail scrutiny and evaluation of the technical and financial proposals of the participating bidders, only three bidders qualified the tender out of which the committee in order of merit recommends M/s RSM Awais Hyder Liaquat Nauman for award of contract being obtained highest marks.
- iv) For transparency purpose the evaluation report may be placed on website of MORa and PPRA for information of all concerned.




