

Subject:- **PROCUREMENT OF MENINGOCOCCAL SEASONAL INFLUENZA VACCINE FOR IN ALLOCATION TO THE INTENDING PILGRIMS-2018**

As per practice in vogue a tender for procurement of Vaccine was floated in the press appeared on 23rd March, 2018. The same was also uploaded on both Ministry and PPRA websites on 23-03-2018. Accordingly, Purchase Committee was met on 10th April, 2018 and gave its recommendations as per Minutes.

2. In pursuance of Rule 35 of PPRA Rule 2004, "the results of bid evaluation shall be announced at least 10 days prior to award of procurement contract", the minutes of the purchase committee duly approved by the Secretary (RA&IH) are forwarded herewith for its uploading on this Ministry and PPRA's websites.

Subject: MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF PURCHASE COMMITTEE FOR VACCINES OF MENINGOCOCCAL, SEASONAL INFLUENZA AND ALLIED EQUIPMENT FOR THE INTENDING PILGRIMS DURING HAJJ OPERATION - 2018

Ministry of Religious Affairs & Interfaith Harmony invited sealed bids from the original manufacturers / multinationals / authorized agents of vaccines, duly approved by the World Health Organization (WHO) and registered with Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan (DRAP), Ministry of National Health Services Regulation & Coordination, for supply of vaccines, specification of which have been described in the tender documents advertised in the daily newspapers (English & Urdu) appeared on 23rd March, 2018 as well as uploaded on both Ministry and PPRA websites on 23rd March, 2018. These vaccines are required as per Saudi Taleemat (Instructions) for inoculation to the Hujjaj before proceeding to Saudi Arabia for performing Hajj. The last date of receipt of tenders was 10-04-2018 till 1430 hrs.

2. The meeting of Vaccine Procurement Committee was held under the chairmanship of D.S (HO) on 10-04-2018 at 1500 hrs in the Committee Room of this Ministry. List of the participants is at **Annex-I & II**. The chair briefed the bidders that in the first instance, technical bids would be opened to ascertain technical suitability of the bids as per requirement of the tender notice for procurement of vaccines and allied equipments for Hajj 2018.

3. Technical bids submitted by the following three firms, were opened by the committee in the presence of bidders. The committee scrutinized the bids and adjudged if the bidders meet technical requirements or otherwise before opening the financial bids:

4. The Committee noted that on 10.04.2018 till 1500 hrs not a single bidder turned up to participate for bidding of Seasonal Flue Vaccine. Last year i.e. 2017 the said vaccine was supplied by M/s Sanofi-Aventus Pakistan upon being the single bidder. The representative of M/s Sanofi-Aventus Pakistan informed the committee that Seasonal Influenza Vaccine is not available by the manufacture till August, 2018 as WHO has released its strains in February, 2018 for preparation of the said Vaccine. Furthermore technical bid of M/s Sanofi Aventis Pakistan was declared unqualified as auto-disposable syringes were not attached / presented with the technical bid. The said shortcoming vis-à-vis rejection of the bid was accepted by the representative of the firm. For the Safety Boxes, only one company M/s Hospital Services, Karachi submitted its Bid. As per rule 42-b (iii) of the PPRA's Rules-2004, minimum of three quotations are required for transparent competition. Therefore, none of the company was qualified for procurement of Safety Box. After thorough technical evaluation, carried out by the Committee, M/s Pfizer Pakistan Limited, 12 Dockyard Road, West Wharf, Karachi was unanimously declared qualified being the only bidder as well as being the propriety item, for which no need for three quotations. The detail of successful bid is hereunder:

5. The Procurement Committee met again to open the only Financial Bid of M/s Pfizer Pakistan Limited, Karachi in the presence of its representative and the members of committee. Details of financial bid is tabulated as under:-

6. In the light of technical and financial evaluation of the bids, the committee unanimously recommended that the following firm may be approved for procurement of Meningococcal vaccines as per quantity and rates given below:-


7. Besides above, the committee has also recommended that for procurement of safety boxes, tenders may be floated again. For timely procurement of Seasonal Flue Vaccine for inoculation to the intending pilgrims, the matter may be referred to WHO through the Director General, Health for guidance and further necessary action.
